#### IH PTSA

(Parent Teacher Student Association)

The Issaquah High PTSA is a private, non-profit organization with members dedicated to serving the students, parents and staff of Issaquah High School. The PTSA also advocates for the health, education, safety, and welfare of all children. This support is manifested primarily through:

#### ASB

(Associated Student Body)

ASB is a formal organization of students, including affiliated student groups such as student clubs, that represents all students of Issaquah High School. ASB governing bodies include: ASB Executive Board, ASB Class Council, ASB Advanced Leadership Class and Student Senate. ASB leaders interact with students, staff, and the administration to voice student needs and concerns, oversee the expenditure of ASB funds, raise funds, promote and sponsor school-wide programs and events, and support sports, activities, and clubs.

Programs funded by ASB must be optional, non-credit, extracurricular, and cultural, athletic, recreational, or social in nature. ASB-funded events and programs include Student Recognition, all-school assemblies and dances, and a variety of night events. ASB funds have also been used to purchase athletic equipment and club materials.

ASB also provides volunteer and fundraising opportunities for students that benefit the greater IHS Community.

#### Booster Club

The Booster Club is a parent-run fundraising organization at IHS that supports ALL student co-curricular activities. These include fine arts, clubs, activities, and sports programs at Issaquah High School. Funds for these programs are generated through membership fees, annual fundraising events and the sale of Issaquah High logo wear.
